- 1. Hourly rate charges are portal to portal.
- 2. All rates are based on one operator, 2nd operator \$100.00 per hour with a four-hour minimum plus overtime and travel.
- 3. Per Diem is \$175.00 per man per day. Some areas will be charged accordingly.
- 4. Rates are for normal working hours, Monday through Friday. Overtime after normal working hours and Saturday is \$40.00 additional per hour per man. On Sunday and holidays, the charge is \$50.00 additional per hour per man.
- 5. In the event diesel fuel reaches \$2.50 per gallon, we will be forced to add the surcharge/environmental fee to cover the costs of fuel, tires, batteries and all petroleum products and the disposal of same.
- 6. Alamo Crane Service, Inc. makes no oral, statutory, or express warranties, including but not limited to implied warranty of merchantability of fitness for a particular purpose.

CUSTOMER RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Customer shall have complete care, custody and control directing the manner and detail of work being performed by Alamo Crane Service, Inc. equipment and personnel during the performance of their request.
- Customer is responsible for rigging load to be lifted unless riggers are requested.
- 3. Customer is responsible for any material that is lost, stolen or damaged.
- 4. CUSTOMER ASSUMES ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR REMOVAL OF EQUIPMENT TO STABLE GROUND IN THE EVENT THAT THE EQUIPMENT IS REQUIRED TO ENTER UNSTABLE AREAS.
- Payment of services rendered is Net 30 days with approved credit. A service charge will be added beginning on the 31st day of 11/2%. A \$30.00 service charge will be charged on all returned checks. Credit Card payments add 3%.
 - *(A) Highway permits are charged each day of travel. If job requires travel to site one day and returns the next day, there will be two permit fees.
 - (B) Highway permits on cranes 60 ton thru 140 ton at a \$175.00 minimum (50-mile round trip). Over the 50-mile round trip, the Permit fee is \$1.75 per mile in addition to the minimum for that crane size, each way.
 - (C) Highway permits on cranes 175 ton and larger have a \$250.00 minimum (50-mile round trip). Over the 50 miles round trip, the permit fee is \$2.50 per mile in addition to the minimum for that crane size, each way.
 - (D) Oversize/overweight loads will require additional permits and engineering. Pricing available upon request.
 - (E) Certified Payroll will be \$75.00 per week for duration of job. OCIP-ROCIP Payroll will be \$150.00 per month for duration of job.
- ** There will be a 4-hour minimum on nights and weekend work

^{***}Freight on Counterweights, boom, jib, etc., is \$150.00 per hour, per truck for travel and rig up/tear down of the crane plus crane charge. Standby charge for trucks is \$100.00 per hour plus overtime. Outside this area the charge will be \$150.00 per hour, per truck for travel and rig up/tear down time for the crane.
